P.R.E.P. Specialist: Works 4 hours per day, Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM - \$9.00 per hour - 7 weeks of employment
 () **P.R.E.P. Specialists** work at the Town’s preschool recreational education program – a preschool program for children ages 3-5. **Applicant should be enrolled in elementary/secondary education courses or a related field.** This program is held on the third floor at the Rotterdam Senior Citizen Center.

R.A.P. Specialist: Works 4 hours per day, Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM - \$9.00 per hour - 7 weeks of employment
 () **R.A.P. Specialists** work at the town’s recreational activity program, a structured program for children ages 6-8. **Applicant should be enrolled in elementary/secondary education courses or a related field.** This program is held at the Pinewood Elementary School.

Sports Camp Specialist: Works 6.5 hours per day, Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM – 3:30 PM - \$9.00 per hour - 7 weeks of employment.
 () **Camp Specialists** work at the town’s summer sports camp for children ages 9-12. **Applicants should be enrolled in elementary/secondary education courses or a related field.** This program is held at Draper Middle School.
