Collections will be held at the *Schenectady County Composting Facility and Resident Recycling Center* on Hetcheltown Rd, Glenville, and at the Dept. of Public Works Facility at 100 Kellar Ave., Rotterdam.

All collections are from 8am - 12noon

The program is for Schenectady County residents and Pre-Registration is Required. Register on-line at www.schenectadycounty.com/hhw or call (518) 386-2225 x9-556

- ✓ A Composting Facility and Resident Recycling Center permit is required to register. Yearly permit is \$20 and can be purchased at the Compost Facility or the Schenectady County Finance Office, 620 State Street, 3rd Floor, Schenectady.
- ✓ Registration opens the Tuesday following the previous recycling day and closes noon on the last business day one week prior to the collection.
- ✓ Registrants will receive confirmation by email or US Mail prior to the event. Please bring this confirmation with you to the collection event.

Accepted materials include leftover or unused household cleaners, paints and paint related items, lawn and garden chemicals, and automobile fluids (except anti-freeze and motor oil). All items should be brought in their original container with the original label if possible.

Only material from households will be accepted. Quantities larger than one carload may be rejected. Call 386-2225 x9-556 with questions or if you have more than 20 one gallon cans or the equivalent.

No waste from commercial, industrial, institutional or not-for-profit generators is allowed. Call 386-2225 x9-556 for information on programs for institutions, small businesses and not-for-profits.

Do NOT bring the following items: Motor oil, antifreeze, lighting, batteries, asbestos, smoke detectors, medical waste explosives (including ammunition), grill-sized propane tanks or larger, electronics, TVs, computers or computer accessories, empty aerosol, or empty paint containers.
