April 19-April 23	Kellar Avenue, Old Fort Avenue, Antonia Hills, Dolan Drive, Mary Lane, Fuez Road, Schalmont School and Garrison Avenue.
April 19-April 23	Eldorado Acres, Manor Court, Beckers Crossing and Shardon Manor.

May 3-May 7	South of Curry Road between Palma Avenue and Westcott Road to Lilac Street. Curry Road and Robinwood Avenue.

June 1-June 4	Highbridge Road area (East of I-890) including St. Jude Drive, Peter Road, Day Road, Devendorf Road, Community Road, Bill Road, and Kings Road, Sherman Street, Polsin Avenue, Boxwood Drive, Palmer Avenue, Polsin Drive and Phyllis Court.
