## NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION OF ROTTERDAM FIRE DISTRICT NO. 3

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the Town Law of the State of New York, that a Special Election of Rotterdam Fire District No. 3 in the Town of Rotterdam will take place on Tuesday October 25, 2022 between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the Carman Firehouse located at 2435 Hamburg St. Schenectady, New York 12303. Qualified voters of the Fire District may vote concerning Proposition Number 1, a resolution approved by the Board of Fire Commissioners subject to mandatory referendum authorizing the issuance of Fire District bonds in an amount not to exceed one million eight hundred thousand dollars and an expenditure of an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars from the Apparatus Capital Reserve Fund.

Proposition Number 1 reads substantially as follows:

### PROPOSITION NUMBER 1

*Shall the bond resolution adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Rotterdam Fire District No. 3, in the Town of Rotterdam, County of Schenectady, State of New York on September 23, 2022, authorizing: the acquisition of a certain Aerial Fire Apparatus including incidental equipment and expenses in connection therewith at an estimated maximum cost of \$1,800,000.00; a sum not to exceed \$200,000.00 to be expended from the Apparatus Capital Reserve; authorizing the issuance of serial bonds of said Fire District at the prevailing rate of interest at the time of closing in an amount not to exceed \$1,800,000.00 to pay a portion of the costs thereof, such amount to be offset by any federal, state, county, and/or local funds received; pledging the faith and credit of said Fire District for the payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds; providing for the levy of a tax to be collected to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds; determining the period of probable usefulness thereof is twenty (20) years; determining that the maximum maturity of serial bonds will be ten (10) years; delegating the power to authorize and sell bond anticipation notes and to fix the details of and to sell serial bonds or statutory installment bonds; containing an estoppel clause and providing for the publication of an estoppel notice, be approved?*

A copy of the full Resolution that is subject to mandatory referendum is available for public inspection at the Fire District office by appointment. Persons interested in reviewing the Resolution in its entirety should contact the Fire District Secretary at the address below to coordinate a date and time for such an inspection.

Only those persons who are residents of Rotterdam Fire District No. 3 on or before September 26, 2022 and who are registered to vote with the Schenectady County Board of Elections on or before October 3, 2022 shall be eligible to vote in this Special Election pursuant to Town Law § 175-a.
