## Town of Rotterdam Brush Transfer Facility Information

At the present time the Town of Rotterdam's Brush Transfer Facility is not open to the public. The brush transfer facility is located on private property.

**Brush and Lawn/ Leaf bags will still be picked up at your residence with no fee.**

Please refer to the Highway Department page at [rotterdamny.org](http://rotterdamny.org) for a schedule of leaf and grass pick up and the procedure for brush pick up.

If you would like to dispose of your own yard waste, the **Schenectady County composting facility** is located at 24 Hetcheltown Road in Glenville, New York. A permit is required to use the facility.

- You can **obtain a permit** at the **County composting facility gatekeeper's office** Monday – Saturday 8:00am – 3:00pm
- You can **also obtain a permit** at the **Schenectady County Finance Department** located at 620 State Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Schenectady, Monday – Friday 9:00am – 5:00pm (July and August hours are 9:00am – 4:00pm)

The charge for the permit is \$20.00 (**cash only**) for all Schenectady County residents. A valid motor vehicle registration is required as proof. Each permit is marked on each visit for yard waste disposal only, in 2 yard increments. No more than 12 visits are permitted per card. Yard waste may be brought in loose or in biodegradable bags. Twigs and branches also may be loose.
